

Solar Eclipse in Pennsylvania

On Monday, April 8, 2024, Pennsylvania will be in the direct line of a total solar eclipse. The last time this occurred was in 1806. The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has issued guidance to all Pennsylvania schools about what can occur during this rare occurrence.

Schools north of us in Erie, Warren, Mercer and Crawford counties are in the direct line where the sky will darken as if it's dawn or dusk. Butler County, as well as most of the rest of the state falls somewhere between 88-99% magnitude.



What does this mean for Warrior Nation?

- Moniteau School District will operate on a normal in-person schedule.
- 2. There will be no cancelation or early dismissal due to the eclipse unless directed by PDE.
- 3. Parents/Guardians who wish to keep their child home in order to observe this event as a family will receive an excused absence from the district. This absence will count toward one of the ten (10) parent excused absences per year.
- 4. Students in the elementary school will not have outdoor recess during the time the eclipse is occurring.
- 5. Caution will be taken at dismissal times to ensure students are safe when departing the school buildings.



SPORTS RECAP

Mason Birckbichler finished second in the 500 Freestyle and 100 Backstroke at the District 9 Swim Meet at Clearfield High School. His time in the 500 Freestyle qualified him for the PIAA State Swimming and Diving Championships at Bucknell University on March 16. Mason finished 28th in the State in the 500 Freestyle.

Kindergarten Registration

Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1st of the current school year in order to register for kindergarten.

In addition to the registration documents (listed above) the Department of Health mandates that each new student complete a physical and dental exam before attending school. We will accept exams completed up to six months prior to registration.

Did you know?

- On average, Americans eat more than 25 pounds of lettuce per person per year.


