



Moniteau Technology One-to-one (1:1) Program

Moniteau School District offers one-to-one (1:1) technology to all students in the district, K-12. This provides each student with an opportunity to use a district-provided device in class as well as at home. By providing 1:1 technology, there are some procedures and policies that students and parents need to be aware of:

- Technology devices are the property of Moniteau School District.
- Students taking devices home daily need to charge their device at home. All devices have an 8-12 hour battery life to last throughout the school day. If the device is not charged, students will need to bring their charger with them to school.
- Devices are filtered 24/7 against inappropriate web content per CIPA (Children's Internet Protection Act) guidelines. Teachers have the ability to monitor student use throughout the day.
- The Moniteau School District Policy 815 – Acceptable Use of Computer Technology is in effect at all times when using a district-owned device and/or a Moniteau School District user account.

As school property, technology devices are included in Moniteau School District Policy 224 - Care of School Property.

Insurance coverage is available for student devices, covering accidental damage, loss, and theft. The district will facilitate insurance claims and continue to handle repair/replacement of devices regardless of insurance coverage. Insurance can be purchased at <https://schooldevicecoverage.com>.
